This young sire has balanced EPDs and phenotype that should produce stylish sire prospects, as well as maternally superior females to keep as replacements. His adjusted 205-day weight was 780 pounds; he showcases length, muscle and capacity on a modest frame; his mature height MH EPD places him in the bottom 95 percent of the breed. His cow energy value \$EN EPD scores in the top 25 percent of the breed. He provides calving ease, wean performance, great docility and handsome structure.

REGISTERED BRED HEIFERS

Lot ONE: This Hoover No Doubt daughter showcases femininity and power in a pretty package. She offers length of

spine and depth of rib, along with good heel and udder potential. Her calves should not only offer pretty phenotype but carcass quality of Certified Angus Beef potential given that her sire is No Doubt and her dam carries both V A R Generation 2100 and PA Power Tool 9108 lineage. Her fertility is backed by her docile dam and grandam, who remain productive in our herd with tight calving intervals and excellent mothering ability. We reserve a right to a flush on this lot 1 prospect.

Lot TWO: This attractive, strong-made S A V Exceptional 7279 daughter carries a clean front, muscle and the stylish and proven combination of sire influencers S A V Resource 1441, N Bar Emulation EXT and S A F Connection in her pedigree. All of our Exceptional calves exhibit exceptional length of spine, and lot 2's dam is thick, sturdy made and AI bred with her third calf on a 358-day calving interval average. Lot 2 is AI bred to Square B Bozeman 8026 (19283610 see EPDs below), a bull that Brian Bell of Square B, Warsaw, MO, believes is one of his best S A V Rainfall sons raised while offering good milk and stout phenotype. He scores a $-.3$ birthweight BW EPD to put him in the top 20 percent for heifer bull prospects while also earning a $+69$ wean weight WW EPD in the top 20 percent for wean performance. We reserve the right to a flush on lot 2.

Lot THREE: This Coleman Charlo daughter offers superior fleshing ability and base width on a foundation of excellent hoof and heel. She boasts a double-digit calving ease direct EPD score of $+10$. Her sound young dam raised a bull calf this summer that was nearly 750 pounds at 205 days. Wide-stanced, correct and well-pedigreed, lot 3 should provide

the desired combo of calving ease and performance. The veterinarian believes her first calf will be a bull based on the November ultrasound.

Lot FOUR: Power. This Jindra Blackout daughter boasts a modest frame packed with muscle and performance. She led this set of heifers in an adjusted 205-day weight of 745 pounds. One of our cattle friends who saw her called her a true bullmaker. Her moderate dam is an S A V Resource daughter who raised a nearly 800-pound Hoover No Doubt bull calf at 205 days.

Lot FIVE: This S A V Rainfall daughter is square-made, deep-ribbed and moderate. Orphaned at a month old, she relied on stealing and forage for her development. Her pedigree includes S A V Resource and S A F Connection — docility and performance are built into her.

Lot SIX: This S A V Exceptional daughter exhibits frame and length; she earned a 706-pound adjusted 205-day weight. Her Pathfinder grandam, G A Minabelle 709, is a coming fifteen-year-old dam that we took out of production last year to enter into full-time donor service. Her dam's calving interval was 357 days on her first five consecutive calves.

Lot SEVEN: This G A Genesis daughter, like lot 9, hails from V A R Generation 2100 and S A V Resource pedigree, as well as a Pathfinder grandam from Connealy Forward. That grandam was sold bred as a coming twelve-year-old. Lot 7 earned an impressive 738 pounds for her adjusted 205-day weight, and her stout dam just raised another heifer earning 747 pounds. Her dam is on track to earn Pathfinder status in our herd. Lot 7 also earns the highest milk EPD of these heifers; her maternal potential is backed by proven and productive dams in her lineage.

Lot EIGHT: This heifer is stacked with Vintage Angus Ranch pedigree; her paternal grandsire is V A R Generation 2100, and her maternal grandsire is V A R Heritage 5038. She offers the lightest birth weight at 69 pounds of the sale heifers, and her grandam is the dam of the capacious lot 11. Lot 11 is one of our featured highlights for replacement dams, and we are reserving a right to a future flush on her. Lot 8's dam is AI bred with her third consecutive calf and is demonstrating excellent and consistent fertility.

Lot NINE: This G A Genesis daughter scores the highest wean weight WW EPD of +72 with this set of sale heifers. Her 2012 Pathfinder grandam is bred yet again; her 2016 S A V Resource dam is deep, wide and capacious; she has exhibited excellent fertility and is AI bred to S A V Emblem. Lot 9, as well as lot 7 and 8, is paternally backed by our first set of Genesis daughters from 2019 that delivered and raised their first calves this past summer; several raised calves weighing well more than 700 pounds (unadjusted) at 205 days. They are great mothers that lick off their calves, stance to be milked and remain gentle and tolerant with human handling of their calves. Good milk, good docility and good mothering ability are traits to expect with our Genesis daughters.

Lot TEN: This attractive G A Reign daughter hails from a pedigreed combo of Alberta Traveler 416, S A V International 2020 and S A V Resource. She is thick-boned, wide-topped and has a broody presence. Her sire, Reign, was one of the most athletic and muscular Resource sons we ever raised. Her Pathfinder grandam was a bred coming fifteen-year-old when we sold her.

REGISTERED REPLACEMENT DAMS

Lot ELEVEN: This powerful S A V Resource daughter hails back to the great landmark sire QAS Traveler 23-4 and is

stacked with revered and proven lineage. She raised a stout and stylish Jindra Blackout son, who weighed 781 pounds at 205 days and will be featured in our 2022 bull sale. She is carried by good hoof EPDs, double-digit calving ease direct and excellent rib and scrotal scores. Thick and square-made, she stamps her progeny. We reserve the right to a flush.

Lot TWELVE: This feminine and stylish G A Reign daughter hails from a pedigree of S A V Resource, S A F Connection and Woodhill Foresight. Her 2007 grandam is the source of our best maternal lineup in the herd and is a current full-time donor cow being flushed at Heart River Genetics. This herd matriarch raised 11 consecutive calves with a wean ratio average of 109. Lot 12 exhibits the balance, style and phenotype that have the potential to make her a foundation dam in other herds. Her first calf is a thick-made, moderate S A V Rainfall bull calf who weighed 697 pounds at 205 days. She is bred to G A Regard 633. This line-breeding selection ensures the famous S A V Blackcap May 4136 carries influence on the maternal and paternal pedigree. Performance, phenotype and docility are bred into her coming calf.

Lot THIRTEEN: double-digit calving ease, good milk and good cow energy value. AI bred to Square B Bozeman 8026. **Lot FOURTEEN:** Daughter of a Pathfinder. Scores in the top 35 percent in 10 EPD traits.

Lot FIFTEEN: Pedigree with 2 generations of Glasoe Angus Pathfinders and donor dams. Double-digit calving ease.

Lot SIXTEEN: Similar pedigree to lot 15: 2 generations of donor Pathfinders. Double-digit calving ease and great docility. **Lot SEVENTEEN:** Double-digit calving ease. Great milk. Docile. Loaded Glasoe pedigree: Montana, Dakota, Complete.

Lot EIGHTEEN: This KM Broken Bow 002 daughter scores in the top 25 percent or higher of 5 \$Values EPDs. Top 35 percent in 12 EPDs. Earned Certified Angus Beef Targeting the Brand stamp. Her young dam's wean ratio is three calves at 108. Her grandam is a 2012 Pathfinder who just raised an 842-pound S A V Raindance son who will be featured in our 2022 bull sale and is bred to our G A Regard 633. Maternal power and performance back this young dam.

Lot NINETEEN: Sale tie of highest milk score. Pedigree of Pathfinder sires: V A R Generation 2100 & Woodhill Foresight.

Lot TWENTY: Daughter of lot 36. Her first calf, a heifer, earned 671 pounds for her 205-day weight. She is bred to G A Regard 633, who is one of the best bulls every raised on our ranch.

Lot TWENTY-ONE: Double-digit calving ease and good milk. Stacked with G A Montana and Colossal Anne pedigree. Her first bull calf earned 750 pounds at 205 days. She is bred to G A Regard 633 like lot 20.

Lot TWENTY-TWO: Resource daughter and granddaughter of a Pathfinder. Hoof improver and great phenotype.

Lot TWENTY-THREE: Top 30 percent or higher in 9 EPDs. Maternally powered in heifer pregnancy, calving ease direct, calving ease maternal, birth weight, cow energy value and docility. She raised a square-made, feminine heifer calf and is AI bred to Hoover No Doubt — the sire of our Lot 1 bred heifer. Hoover No Doubt boasts superior base width, udder attachment and teat shape and excellent hooves on a sound frame.

Lot TWENTY-FOUR: Backed by three consecutive generations of G A Pathfinder dams. Top 35+ percent in 8 EPDs. **Lot TWENTY-FIVE:** Resource daughter and highest wean weight EPD in the sale. Daughter of a Pathfinder.

Lot TWENTY-SIX: Several Pathfinders in maternal pedigree. Wide-made.

Lot TWENTY-SEVEN: Double-digit calving ease and good milk.

Lot TWENTY-EIGHT: The only HA Cowboy Up daughter of the sale. Top 30+ percent in 15 EPD categories. Top yearling weight score of the sale and in the top 2 percent breed-wide. Tied for top sale milk score. Bred to Regard.

Lot TWENTY-NINE: Thick-made Resource daughter. Scores in the top 30+ percent in 10 EPD categories.

Lot THIRTY: Another solid Resource daughter with S A F Connection pedigree. Correction of data sheet: her S A V

Emblem bull calf weighed 713 pounds, not 731, at 205 days and will be featured in our 2022 bull sale.

Lot THIRTY-ONE: Top 30+ percent in 9 EPD categories. Connection and Montana pedigree. Highly docile.

Lot THIRTY-TWO: Her Roosevelt heifer earned 705 pounds at 205 days. Stacked w/ Colossal Anne & Montana pedigree.

Lot THIRTY-THREE: Top 35+ percent in 10 EPD categories. S A F Connection and S A V Harvester pedigree.

Lot THIRTY-FOUR: She earns the Certified Angus Beef Targeting the Brand logo and scores in the top 30+ percent in 9 EPD categories. She is backed by two generations of

Pathfinders. Her Roosevelt daughter earned 706 pounds at 205 days. Her first four calves average 74 pounds at birth and a 368-day calving interval. Dependable performance.

Lot THIRTY-FIVE: Her first five consecutive calves have averaged 78 pounds at birth on a 368-day calving interval. Her wean ratio on those five calves is 101. She scores in the top 35+ percent or higher in 10 EPD categories.

Lot THIRTY-SIX: Her dam is the Pathfinder grandam of lot 35. This S A V International daughter has raised five consecutive calves; her stylish 2020 daughter is lot 10.

Lot THIRTY-SEVEN: This broody, powerful dam raised her last bull calf with a 205-day weight of 810 pounds; he was the top S A V Elation son sold at our 2021 sale. She boasts Connealy Forward, S A F Connection and S A V Net Worth pedigree. She is docile but incredibly protective the first few days after her calf is born. We give her and her calf plenty of room several days before we handle the calf. She averages a 104 wean ratio on her first four calves. She earned Pathfinder status with those first four calves and a 353-day calving interval.

Lot THIRTY-EIGHT: This dependable dam averages a 363-day calving interval on her first six calves and a 76-pound birth weight. She is the daughter of our highly fertile and productive 2007 G A Minnabelle 709 — who raised 12 consecutive calves with a 110 wean ratio in a 367-day calving interval and is now in full time donor service at Heart River Genetics. Longevity and fertility: lot 38 could easily raise another 6 calves or more in her future.

Lot THIRTY-NINE: This sweet S A F Connection daughter is late bred, but has raised great calves for us (five bulls in a row). She is a hoof improver and scores in the top 1 percent for claw and top 20 percent for angle EPD. Her calves are stylish and correct.

Although she is an older cow, she still scores in the top 30 percent or higher in 9 EPD categories.

Lot FORTY: Her last three consecutive calves earned a 104, 106 and 107 wean ratio. Her heaviest calf yet, G A Exceed 134, is a highlight in our bull pen. He weighed 823 pounds at 205 days and will sell in 2020.
